

Presidential Graduate Opportunities for Leadership Development (GOLD) Fellowship

The University of California Washington Program (UCDC) announces its first annual GOLD Fellowship opportunity. This opportunity will offer selected graduate students an opportunity to spend a quarter, semester or summer term in residence in Washington, DC for the purpose of conducting public policy research on issues of national significance and assist in providing professional development training to undergraduate students. Fellowship recipients will receive a TAship, which includes payment of California Resident Tuition and Student Services Fees in addition to free housing at the UC Washington Center. Selection will be based on a combination of demonstrated interest in public policy and/or public service; academic accomplishment and potential for a career in public policy or public service.

Submissions should include:

- Statement on public policy research interest and proposed research
- Current CV
- Recent teaching evaluations
- Abstract of dissertation
- Transcript with current GPA
- Two faculty letters of recommendation (one must be your dissertation advisor)
